MAIL CHANGES Starting June 1, BHV employees will no longer be handling resident's mail. If you will be away from your residence for an extended period of time, it is recommended to enroll in USPS Hold Mail Service. You will need to sign in to or create a USPS.com account to begin an online USPS Hold Mail request.

USPS Hold Mail service will hold ALL mail (including letters and packages) safely at your local Post Office facility until you return, **for up to 30 days**. You can pick up your mail at your local Post Office location or your letter-carrier can deliver your mail on the ending date you specify. To hold your mail longer or to reroute your mail, please sign up for a forwarding service. You can make your request up to 30 days in advance or as early as the next scheduled delivery day.
