<u>NEW ORDINANCE</u> At their July 10, 2023 meeting the BHV Board of Trustees adopted Ordinance No. 60 to recodify the Village Code of Barton Hills Village. Join Our Barton Hills Effort to Improve Safety of the M-14 Interchange and Retain the Eastbound Barton Drive ramps!

On June 23, MDOT notified its M-14 Advisory Council (BHV has a rep on this Council) that MDOT was preparing to recommend the permanent closure of the eastbound Barton Drive exit and entrance ramps effective 2024. Further, though MDOT estimates a 44.7% reduction in crashes across the entire interchange over 5 years by only spending \$367,000, it let us know it's *not* implementing its own recommendations to do so. Instead, MDOT wishes to seek \$43 million for a dual roundabout – negatively impacting our residents' quality of life.

As a result, on July 10 the Trustees approved a statement in which we oppose the closing of the ramps and urge MDOT to both implement its own recommendations to reduce crashes by 44.7% across the interchange and eliminate the dual roundabout as a long-term solution.

We have engaged the support of our State Senator Sue Shink and State Representative Jennifer Conlin. We will be going door-to-door in the Village for residents to sign a petition to signify support. Also, a petition will be at the Clerk's office (199 Barton Shore Drive, Ann Arbor, MI 48105) for residents to sign during office hours - Monday through Friday 8:30AM – 3:30PM.
