

Please Attend! MDOT's presentation specifically for Barton Hills Village residents and Ann Arbor Township staff/ reps is **6pm tonight!** MDOT will review the final draft recommendations of its Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) study of the M-14 interchange at Barton Drive, Whitmore Lake Road, and Main Street.

We urge MDOT to spend just \$486,000* to make the entire interchange 44.7% safer over 5 years and to retain the existing EB exit/entrance Barton Dr ramps. If you concur, this is your chance to let MDOT know!

Instead, MDOT wants to close the EB ramps in 2024 and then seek \$43 million to build a dual roundabout sometime in the future. Tonight is your opportunity to speak directly with MDOT – please attend!

* MDOT's 2021 figure was \$316k. To adjust that amount for inflation, we first used COLA to come up with a figure of \$387k. We've since learned the better approach is to use the Federal Highway Administration's [national highway construction cost index](#) of 27% for 2022, and 20% for Q1-2 2023.
